Notes:

R.S.O. for additional combinations equals the sum of the unit size widths plus 1" and the sum of the unit heights plus 3/4".

M.O. for additional combinations is the brick mold width or height plus 1/2".

R.S.O. for stacked combinations mullied two or more wide and over 84" in width or height, it is recommended to add a filler for each stacked layer in height. Thickness of the filler may vary due to dimensions of the overall unit.
